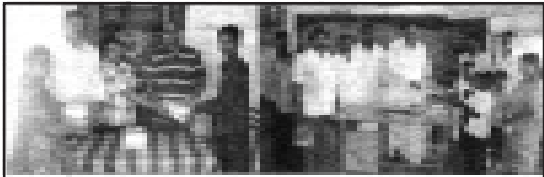


Helping the object poor is the Motive


