13th July, 1947 is the day Sri. P.Ranjan babu was born. Smt. Pullagura Deenamma, his grandmother was born in 1880's. His father Dr. Pullagura Viswanadham who was a teacher, preacher and also a doctor. Mother Smt. Santoshamma was an able woman his family has been leading a revolutionary, restless, committed, sacrificing struggle for the welfare of the Dalit Community of his birth for over 133 years. Dr. Ranjan Babu is the member of such family's third generation. Which has devoted his life for the welfare of Dalit society ignoring the personal benefits. Born in such a family, Dr.Ranjan Babu has lives around the Nation and abroad too. He has been leading many collective struggles for the better living prospects among the Dalit Community. 13th July is the birthday of such determined leader of Dalits. The day has been observed as “Day of Commitment” by thousands of Dalit Volunteers since 1985. Ranjan Babu who was born in his child hood, took inspiration from his parents who thought against the evil practice of untouchability. Being inspired by his grandmother Smt. Deenamma who spirited the lives of the Dalits with her endeavors, Sri.Ranjan Babu took the oath of prospering the lives of Dalits. Since his childhood he has studied the state of Dalits across the country. As a student, he founded the student Christian movement. Being the leader of the movement, he visited many Dalits across the Nation and came to know of the extreme misery their lives. He contrasted the lives of the Dalits with his course of study. “Social Science Psychology” and found the roots of untouchability. He analyzed the ways of religious, political, cultural society and resolves to prosper the Dalit Community. He believed that liberation can be achieved through liberty with the concept “Education

Liberation” he formed organizations with students at college and university levels. He spirited the rural youth and led them according to the existing scenarios. He completed his post graduation and joined as lecturer at AC College, Guntur. There, he motivated thousands of Dalit students for social service. These students worked for the prosperity of lives of Dalits in their villages with the slogan Randi – Rajyadhinethalu Kandy (Come – Become the sovereigns). Thus he thundered the villages for the rights of Dalits. He experienced the contrast between his vocation and avocation. In 1977 the state of Andhra Pradesh was severely struck by cyclone it created a huge havoc in the state. Sri. Ranjan Babu visited the cyclone affected regions. He was moved at the sight of rotten carcasses. He took care of the Dalit victims. Many of the representatives from various Governments, many persons, many organizations came forward to help the flood affected victims the death told was 10,000 people. He extended his services to the victims. Though many of his companions left the region for the fear of epidemics, Sri. Ranjan Babu with the determined soul didn't deter from his services. With the heart filled with the ideals of Christ – Ambedkar, he roamed the whole region and found the dreadful facts. Of the 10,000 people died, 7000 people belong to Dalit Communities. What is the reason for these deaths? Who are responsible for this? When will be the solution found to this situation? These questions echoed in and around the Nation. Sri.P.Ranjan Babu who rouses these questions investigated the situation and gathered the answers the answers to these questions reflect the poverty among the Dalits, untouchability, caste discrimination, inhumanity.

Motivated by the saying “Truth makes you the independent” Sri. Ranjan Babu gave up his job and took up charity. The foundation of CARDS for fulfilling the needs of dalits for the past 34 years he has been serving the Dalits the situation in 1980 – Before CARDS being founded

- * No Work.
- * No house
- * No clothes
- * No freedom for speech
- * Inhumane non – Dalits – 95% of the Dalits are barded laborers.

- ✿ Quest for food – colonial living of the Dalits murders, assaults are common with the Dalits women – Death is the answer if questions.
- ✿ Less wages - Dependent lives – a kind of slavish life.
- ✿ No land – no food – struggle – social oppression – cases by the police - unfair charges of thefts – caste panchayat. Many organizations, societies, persons, sympathizers have come up with the motive of prospering the lives of Dalits.

In the guise of being charitable to Dalits many crave for acquiring the blessing of god. An attitude with the motive of eradicating the society of exploitation and for that purpose a adopting a policy was born on 13th July.

For Realizing the attitude. Forming a team and working for the purpose without caning for lives, money is an adventure. That's why July 13th can be considered as the day of adventure.

For reeling the truth that he found Sri Ranjan Babu has devoted his life. Having never bent to any kind of weaknesses he developed a character where he didn't pave way to wealth, wine and women. That's why July 13th was considered as the birth of truth fullness

For the past 33 years, Sri Ranjan Babu has never deviated from his path even though he was attacked physically, socially and economically. He believed that redemption is possible through education. He expanded his world and energized his team in a peaceful manner for prospering the lives of Dalits. That's why 13th July is the day of Peace.

In his 65 years of public life, he spirited the lives of Dalits with transparency and decentralization of power. He led an independent struggle for solutions to the misery experienced by the people. That's why July 13th is the birth of "people's path".

FIRST ITEM OF BALA BATA

Rayalaseema Regional Conference “Study with Songs & Games” Giddaluru Meetings.

Important Issues:

1. After identifying the conditions Dalits in their respective villages, Bala Bata Development organizers who gave to give training in Bala Bata wrote many songs.
2. The Do's who have believed that education is for liberation, are mobilizing dalit students towards education while they themselves are continuing their studies.
3. Even today there are village, thandas, gudems (hamlets) which do not know the value of education.
4. Bala Batas are taking initiation in dalit literature and cultural forms.
5. The villages which do not have Bala Bata centres are distanced from progress even today.
6. In the villages where there are Bala Bata centre's. The students are taking part in all the fields.
7. Bala Batas are paving the way for the future development of dalit students. Those students who joined Bala Bata have reached to the Post Graduate level and are doing jobs.
8. In all the villages and hamlets, youth with discretion is being formed with this we can mould the youth through Bala Bata who can formulate the aims of Ambedkar as the aims of CARDS organization.
9. Through the establishment of Best Clubs, Bala Batas are acting as catalysts to develop leadership qualities and are producing powerful dalit leaders.
10. All the RCO's and ACO's are taking it as part of their responsibility to identify the areas which are lagging behind in the field of education and are establishing Bala Bata's in those areas.
11. With the Co-operation of parents the DO's are continuing in Bala Batas by putting great attention in the matters of education of dalit children.
12. The statistics of the government are revealing that the number of students in elementary schools and Residential Schools has increased

after the establishment of Bala Batas and there are many instances where Bala Bata DO's are appreciated by officials.

13. Singing Bala Bata songs and performing various cultural programs during special occasions in Government Schools is an evidence of the craftsmanship of the DO's.
14. By observing the difference between the children who attend Bala Bata and who do not attend Bala Bata in the areas of education, thoughts, discipline, habits, the parents are sending their children to Bala Bata. The parents are encouraging Bala Batas through DO's.
15. In some villages parents are requesting to continue Bala Batas even in the months of April and May for the sake of their children.
16. Training in songs and cultural awareness classes should be conducted for the DO's of Bala Bata
17. Many Girijan Bala Bata's should be established and the culture of the girijans which has become extinct should be protected.
18. It will be helpful for the RCO's/ACO's to have familiarity with the MRO's and MEO's of the Government offices.
19. Annual celebrations of Bala Bata should be celebrated every year region wise and as a result the Bala Bata activities will reach the people through DO's.
20. Bala Bata calendar should be prepared on the lines of the Govt. calendar and by conducting Bala Bata programs on a large scale, Bala Batas should be developed.
21. DO's are preparing Bala Bata children against oppression untouchability and ignorance.
22. RCO's and ACO's are boldly facing the atrocities of land lords and leaders in villages with the inspiration of Dr.P.Ranjan Babu's maxim “I am not inferior to anybody and nobody is superior to me”.
23. Education supported by songs and games will make dalit children closer to education.
24. During Daserrah and sankranthi holidays, dalita, Bala Bata songs tour should be conducted.
25. Bala Bata will be helpful for the unity and development of Bahujans if the news of Bala Bata reaches every village.

SECOND ITEM OF BALA BATA

Regional Conference – Guntur. “Greenness and Cleanliness”
Meetings.

Important Issues:

1. When ACO's, RCO's DCO's and DD's go to Bala Bata visit they should identify those students who are unclean and educate the parents of those students who are unclean and who are in torn clothes and make the parents understand their responsibility about the cleanliness of their children by detailing them about the aims of Bala Bata.
2. As children are important for the progress of our country green trees are also equally important for our country.
3. Growing trees is safety; felling trees is famine.
4. If we grow trees there will be greenness and cleanliness around us. By releasing oxygen, trees prevent pollution. Hence, we are building a healthy society by growing trees through Bala Bata.
5. If a seedling is planted in front of a child's house, it gives happiness by showing the growth of the child along with itself.
6. Dr.P.Ranjan Babu, Director, CARDS has formulated a plan for the sake of poor dalits and for the founding of a health society for the future generation.
7. In the Bala Bata Mother's meeting local Govt. Doctors, Nurses and health organizers gave the health tips.
8. In dalit localities, drainage and side canals must be made available and they should be maintained cleanly without dirt, flies and Mosquitoes to prevent dalit localities from diseases.
9. For the construction of latrines the state Govt. gives an aid of Rs. 9,500/- . In addition to it and with the aid of the organization and beneficiary's share, people can safeguard their health by constructing latrines.
10. In our counting majority of inhabitants are dalits. These dalits should cultivate to lead a life of cleanliness and dignity along with others in the society.
11. If one is clean others give respect.
12. There is scarcity of latrines in dalit localities. Hence most of them go for excretion in the open places. As a result diseases spread among dalits in the rainy season. So if they construct latrines they can be distanced from diseases.
13. Dalits will be healthy if they bury the corpses of animal's away from their residential areas.
14. The students studying in Bala Bata is continuing his studies and has become a model for others by maintaining cleanliness. He has cultivated the habit of helping those in need.
15. We should put in effort to prevent the spread of Malaria and Filarial in dalit colonies by spraying bleaching powder.

THIRD ITEM OF BALA BATA

Telangana – 2 Regional conference “Growing kitchen Gardens”
Meetings.

Important Issues:

1. The Koya tribe, belonging to scheduled tribe, residing in the agency area of West Godavari District has no transport facilities in the forest region.
2. The villagers buy their daily needs once in a week in the village fair and sell their forest products in the fair itself.
3. It is a great problem for them to buy vegetables for a whole week as they do not possess much money.
4. Though they buy vegetables for a week, they would not be fresh for the week long.
5. Every family has a big courtyard.
6. In these conditions “Growing kitchen Garden Program” of Bala Bata has become very useful and profitable for the Koya Tribe people of this area.
7. For three months, they are able to gain various kinds of vegetables without paying any amount of money.
8. Besides growing kitchen gardens, they are also growing fruit trees and flower plants in the surrounding of their houses.
9. They are mouldings the surroundings of their houses beautifully, healthily, neatly and financial profitably.
10. Through the earning of money is meager the children and their parents are able to get nutrition's food through food through different kinds of vegetables.
11. They are new converting themselves from hunting culture to production culture.
12. Dalits can lead a self-esteemed life through growing kitchen gardens.
13. If they insert seeds of vegetables in the vacant space before their houses they can economic income and oxygen too.
14. Qualitative vegetables are helpful not only for eating but also for living healthy.
15. As all the dalits are leading their lives as agricultural labourers, they return home from their work. At 7 p.m. so instead of going to market for vegetable they can prepare curries with the vegetables of their own kitchen gardens.

FOURTH ITEM OF BALA BATA

Telangana – I Regional conference – “self Help Life Style” Meetings.

Governments schemes at Village, Mandal, District level:

1. Through Anganwadi centres (ICDS) the pregnancy women will be given nutritious food freely for healthy children from 3rd month to 9th month.
2. Free medical camps must be conducted for children and parents and iron tablets should be given to Bala Bata children.
3. Matric scholarships should be applied from 5th class to 10th class
4. Efforts should be made to see that C.C roads in dalit localities and fundamental comforts in dalit localities under 12 finance scheme are provided.
5. Efforts should be put in for bore wells and water pipe lines through mini water tanks in dalit localities.
6. Efforts should be made to see that old people would get pension regularly under. Old age pension scheme.
7. Efforts should be made to see that rice would be given on ration cards properly.
8. We should see that the hundred days work for SC's and ST's under employment guarantee scheme should be enjoyed by SC's and ST's.
9. We should see that dalits will get job cards and their post office accounts should be opened.
10. Government will provide seeds to dalits to cultivate the land assigned to them under the cultivation land development programme (CLDC).
11. We should see that the assigned land and uncultivated land in the villages should be given to dalit freely as per the constitutional provision.
12. We should identify the pond lands and tank lands and should wage constitutional struggles with the government to see that those lands are distributed to dalits.
13. We should encourage dalit youth so that they try to get employment under Rajeev Yuva Kiranalu scheme.
14. We should see that the dalit students would get employment through loans under swasakti step scheme after competition of their 10th, Inter and Degree studies.
15. Under Bangaruthalli scheme, Government will deposit Rs. 2000/- for the hospital expenses when a girl child is born and the Govt. will deposit Rs. 21000/- in Banks until the girl child reaches 21 years of age.
