Development Programmes

The Director, CARDS organization desires that the staff of CARDS and ACO's, RCO's & DCO's of Bala Bata working at state level should strive for the progress of SC's and ST's and fee that the following Govt. programmes reach the parents of Bala Bata children. The Government has created opportunity for two thousand people in every district of our state. As part of our development programme for the last four decades, the Govt. has increased the subsidy for dalits in the SC sub plan.

2013-2014 PLAN OF ACTION

District scheduled castes services and cooperation society was established in 1975 in accordance with the cooperative act 1964. The principal aim of this society was to provide monitory benefit for the scheduled castes who are living below the poverty line and achieve economic development in them.

With the aim of the development of scheduled castes the Government has given legality for the formulation of sub-plan and aimed at seeing the funds and economic resources belong to SC's only.

As part of sub-plan for scheduled castes during 2013-14 it was approved by the principal secretary, Social welfare, A.P Secretariat, and the Vice Chairman and Managing Director, A.P. scheduled castes co-operative financial society, Hyderabad set forth the goals as to attain benefit for scheduled caste. The temporary plan of action was formulated the unit value of 5604 at 60% Rs. 60000 to Rs. 100000 with subsidy.

The conditions for gaining financial help :-

1. One must belong to scheduled caste and get the scheduled caste certificate through "Mee-Seva".
2. One must belong to Guntur Dist. And get the residential certificate through "Mee-Seva".
3. First preference must be given to poor residents.
4. Preference will be given to the members of DARA and MEPMA groups
5. One must have knowledge about the scheme which is going to be implemented.
6. One should not have received any financial benefit from this office previously.
7. One must be aged from 21 to below 45
8. One must have the annual income of Rs. 60000 in the rural area or Rs. 75000 in the urban area.

Govt. Schemes at Villages, Mandals and District Level

1. Through Anganvadi Centres (ICDS) healthy and nutrition food for pregnancy woman's child will be given freely from 3 to 9 months.
2. Health camps should be conducted and Iron tablets should be given freely for Balabata children and parents.
3. We should see that the children of 5th class to 10th class apply for Metric scholarships.
4. We should see that water is supplied to dalit localities through pipe lines, Bore wells and mini water tanks under the J R Y scheme.
5. We should strive to see that the poor get pension under old age pension scheme.
6. We should see that the public get the rice given by the govt on ration cards.
7. We should see that dalits get hundred days work provided by the government to Dalits and Girijans under Employment Guarantee Scheme.
8. We should see that dalits get job cards and their bank accounts are open for their benefit.
9. Under the cultivation Land Development Programme (C L D P) the Government will supply needs to dalits for the cultivation of their lands.
10. We should see that patters will be granted to the dalits for the assigned land and uncultivated lands in the villages according to the guarantee of the laws of constitution.
11. We should recognise the tank lands in the villages and conduct struggles in a constitutional way and see that the lands are distributed to the dalits.
12. We should strive to encourage young men in a way to get self – employment under the Rajeev Yuva Kiranalalu Scheme.
13. Under the Swasakti step scheme, the dalit students get employment through loan after the completion of 10th class, Inter , Degree education.
14. Under Bangaru Thalli Programme in 2013 – 14 the government will deposit in bank Rs 2000/- for the hospital expenditure if the mother give birth to a female child and Rs.21000/- till the child completes 21 year.
15. The women who are members of Self Help Group will be given the insurance of Rs. 100000 under “Abhaya Hastam” and also pension of Rs. 500.
